Lowell residents (46356 zip code) - \$50.00 for one dog


(add \$5.00 for each additional dog)


Non- Lowell Residents - \$60.00 for one dog

(add \$5.00 for each additional dog)

Senior Citizens (65 and older) and those on Disability – 1/2 Price

 You **ONLY** need to fill out a new Registration Form/s if there are corrections/updates that need to be made OR if you are adding another dog to your membership in 2010. Registration forms are available at the Lowell Parks Dept. Office, Bardens Animal Clinic, Hebron Animal Hospital, in the white mailbox by the stop sign in the Bark Park Parking Lot, or on the website under “FORMS.”

 Lanyards will NOT be replaced in 2010 - just the pass and dog tag/s. If you need to purchase a new lanyard, they are available in the Parks Department for \$2.50.

 Please make checks payable to the TOWN OF LOWELL and bring your registration form/s (only if you have changes/updates), and your current vaccination records (Rabies, Parvo, Distemper, and Leptospirosis DHPPL) to the Parks Dept. Office at 17105 Cline Avenue between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday **OR**...Mail a copy of your registration form/s (only if you have changes/updates), current vaccination records, and a self-addressed stamped envelope to:
LOWELL PARKS DEPT., 17105 CLINE AVENUE, LOWELL, IN 46356. Your 2010 pass and dog tag/s will be mailed back to you in your self-addressed envelope.

PLEASE NOTE: Lake County Ordinance #1244 F states that Pit Bull and Pit Bull mixes are prohibited from participating in unleashed dog parks. We are required to uphold this county ordinance.
