**Non- Lowell Residents - \$60.00 for one dog
(add \$5.00 for each additional dog)**

**Senior Citizens (65 and older) and those on Disability –
1/2 Price**

-  **Review the Bark Park Membership Rules.**
-  **Complete a separate Registration Form for each dog you will be adding to your membership.**
-  **Have copies of the current vaccination records for your dog/s to submit to the Lowell Parks Department, along with your registration fee.**
-  **You will receive one pass and lanyard for you to wear, as well as tag/s to be worn by your dog/s while at the park.**

Please make checks payable to the TOWN OF LOWELL and bring your registration form/s, as well as your dog/s current vaccination records (Rabies, Parvo, Distemper, and Leptospirosis DHPPL) to the Parks Dept. Office at 17105 Cline Avenue between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday ...**OR**...Mail a copy of your registration form/s, current vaccination records, and a self-addressed stamped envelope to:

LOWELL PARKS DEPARTMENT, 17105 CLINE AVENUE, LOWELL, IN 46356.

Your 2010 pass and dog tag/s will be mailed back to you in your self-addressed envelope.

PLEASE NOTE Lake County Ordinance #1244 F states that Pit Bull and Pit Bull mixes are prohibited from participating in unleashed dog parks. We are required to uphold this county ordinance.
